The **Association for Research in Cultures of Young People (ARCYP)** was founded in 2008 by a group of scholars to promote the study of and research in young people's cultures and texts, in Canada and internationally, across a range of disciplines, and to build an understanding of such scholarship that defines "young people," "culture," and "text" broadly. Its secondary aim is to create interdisciplinary spaces for advocates, activists, and scholars to exchange research on young people's texts and cultures, and to create opportunities for collaborations between academic scholars and members of community organizations that work with young people's texts and cultures. Led by President Peter E. Cumming, the association is currently managed within and supported by the **Children's Studies Program** and the **Department of Humanities** in the **Faculty of Liberal Arts & Professional Studies** at York University.

Activities of the association include on-line listserv discussions, annual meetings, publications of roundtables in *Jeunesse: Young People, Texts, Cultures*, and joint sessions with the Association of Canadian College and University Teachers of English (ACCUTE) at the annual Congress of the Humanities and Social Sciences. Our joint session in Fredericton in May 2011 will focus on theorists of childhood; children and war; migration and childhood; and play, games, and gaming in youth cultures.
